DANCE POLICY

- In order to address student safety, Windsor High School Administrators/Designees may administer, in a predetermined or random pattern, a breathalyzer test to ticket holders upon entry to or exit from the dance and/or upon reasonable suspicion of student being under the influence. In addition, Windsor High School Administrators/Designees may also conduct a search of students' clothing, bags and person.
- Dancing styles that include the touching of breasts, buttocks, or genitals is not allowed. When dancing front to back, all dancers must keep hands off knees and hands off the dance floor at all times: **Both bodies should be able to support own body weight and remain upright.**
- Students will receive a bracelet upon entry of the dance and a students' 1st offense of dancing inappropriately will be tracked by marking a line on their bracelet; on 2nd offense, students will be directed to leave the dance floor, their parents/guardians will be contacted, and students will be removed from dance. **Further violations may result in more serious Admin disciplinary actions and students losing the privilege of attending future dances.** No refunds will be given to any student asked to leave a dance due to a violation of these rules.
- All bags, purses, outerwear, etc, may be searched upon entry to the dance and must be checked into coat check. Only phones are allowed to be carried into the dance.
- Students may not bring outside food or drink into the dance, except with doctor/hospital medical authorization provided in advance with the Dance Contract.
- Dance participants may not leave the dance and return. Students may leave the dance **one hour** prior to the conclusion of the dance.
- Administration reserves the right to modify the environment in response to student safety.
- Effective Fall 2018: Any student with a discipline suspension during the 60 days prior to the dance, or not in good-standing based on attendance truancy (Truancy Letter #2 or higher), may not attend the dance.

DRESS CODE

- Shirts: must be worn and buttoned at all times.
- Necklines: must not go lower than the middle of the breast bone.
- Garments with Slits: must not be higher than the middle of the thigh.
- Backless dresses and Cutouts: must be at or higher than the natural hipbone.
- Strapless dresses: acceptable as long as there is no plunging neckline.
- Two-Piece dresses: acceptable as long as the gap between the top and bottom piece is no more than 2 inches.
- Mesh Fabric and Inserts: must be lined and follow the dress code above.
